THE COUNTY COMMISSION OF MASON COUNTY met in the Commission room of the courthouse on Thursday, September 26, 2024 at 4:00 p.m. in regular session. Present were Tracy Doolittle, President (via telephone); Rick Handley, Commissioner; Diana Cromley, County Clerk; and Jason Bechtle, Administrator.

Tracy Doolittle called the meeting to order. Diana Cromley gave the opening prayer, and Rick Handley led the pledge of allegiance.

Eleanor Hoffman and Janet Kincaid with WVU Extension appeared before the Commission in support of recognizing National 4-H Week.

Upon motion by Doolittle and unanimous agreement, the Commission approved observing National 4-H Week in Mason County from October 6 through October 12, 2024.

Brent Clark updated the Commission on the status of Mason County PSD projects, a copy of which is attached, and requested \$25,000 in additional funding for a study on the northern area where Fidelus and Babcock-Wilcox will be locating and \$25,000 for sewer studies and inquiries for other areas.

Upon motion by Doolittle and unanimous agreement, the Commission approved the Mason County PSD's request for a total contribution of \$50,000 to be paid from ARPA funds for the above-mentioned projects.

Upon motion by Doolittle and unanimous agreement, effective September 27, 2024, the Commission lifted the county-wide burning ban.

Upon motion by Doolittle and unanimous agreement, the Commission approved Estate Appointments, Affidavits for Small Estates, Orders Appointing Fiduciary Commissioners, Waivers of Final Settlements, Reports of Receipts and Disbursements, Commissioner's Reports of Claims and Final Settlement, and Applications for Corrections of Erroneous Assessments. Copies of which are attached hereto.

Upon motion by Doolittle and unanimous agreement, the Commission minutes from the previous meeting were approved with no omissions or corrections thereto.

The Commission executed the Bills and Purchase Orders as required.

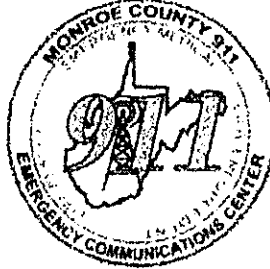

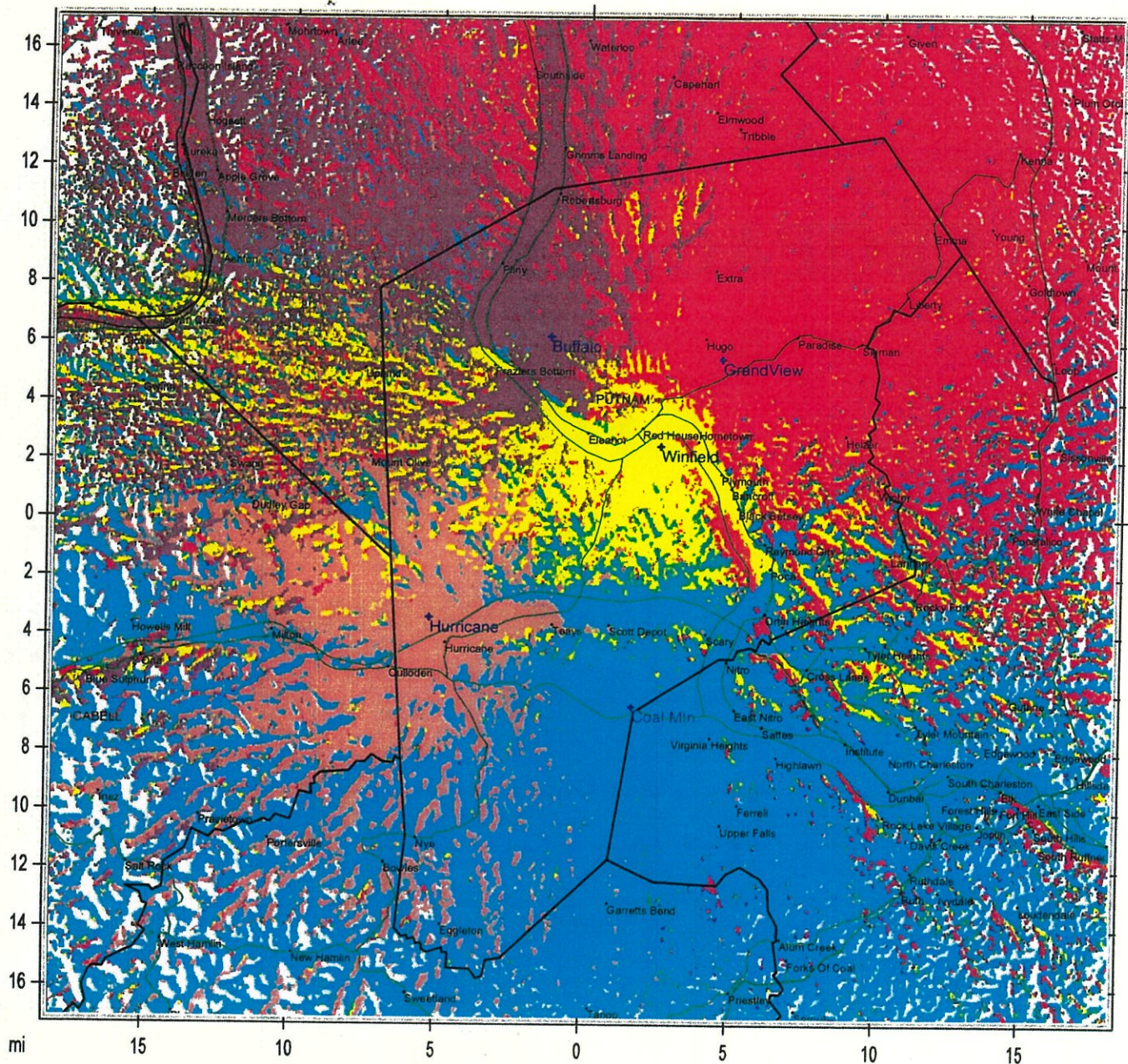

Putnam Existing VHF Talk Back Most Likely Server (MLS)

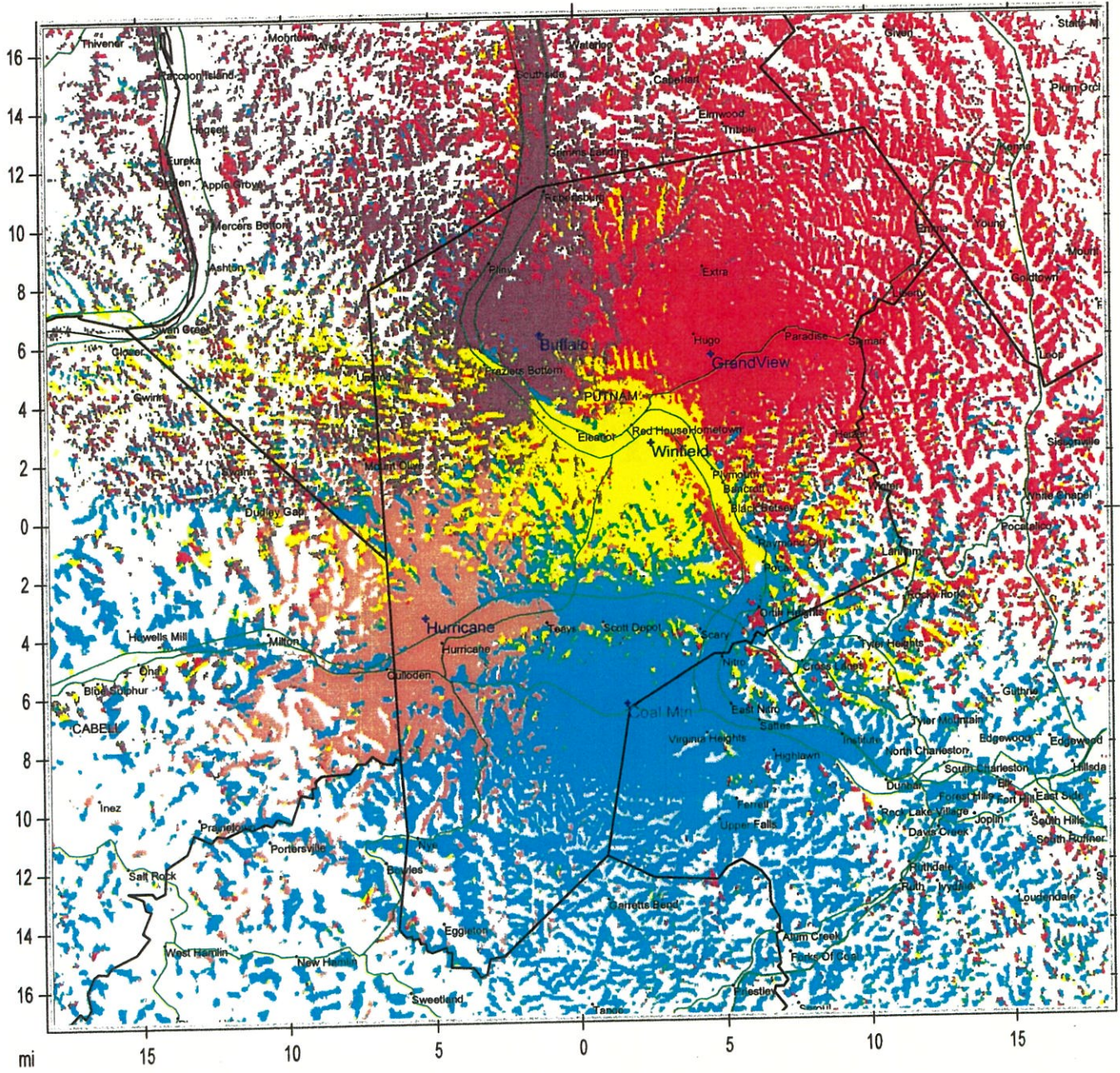

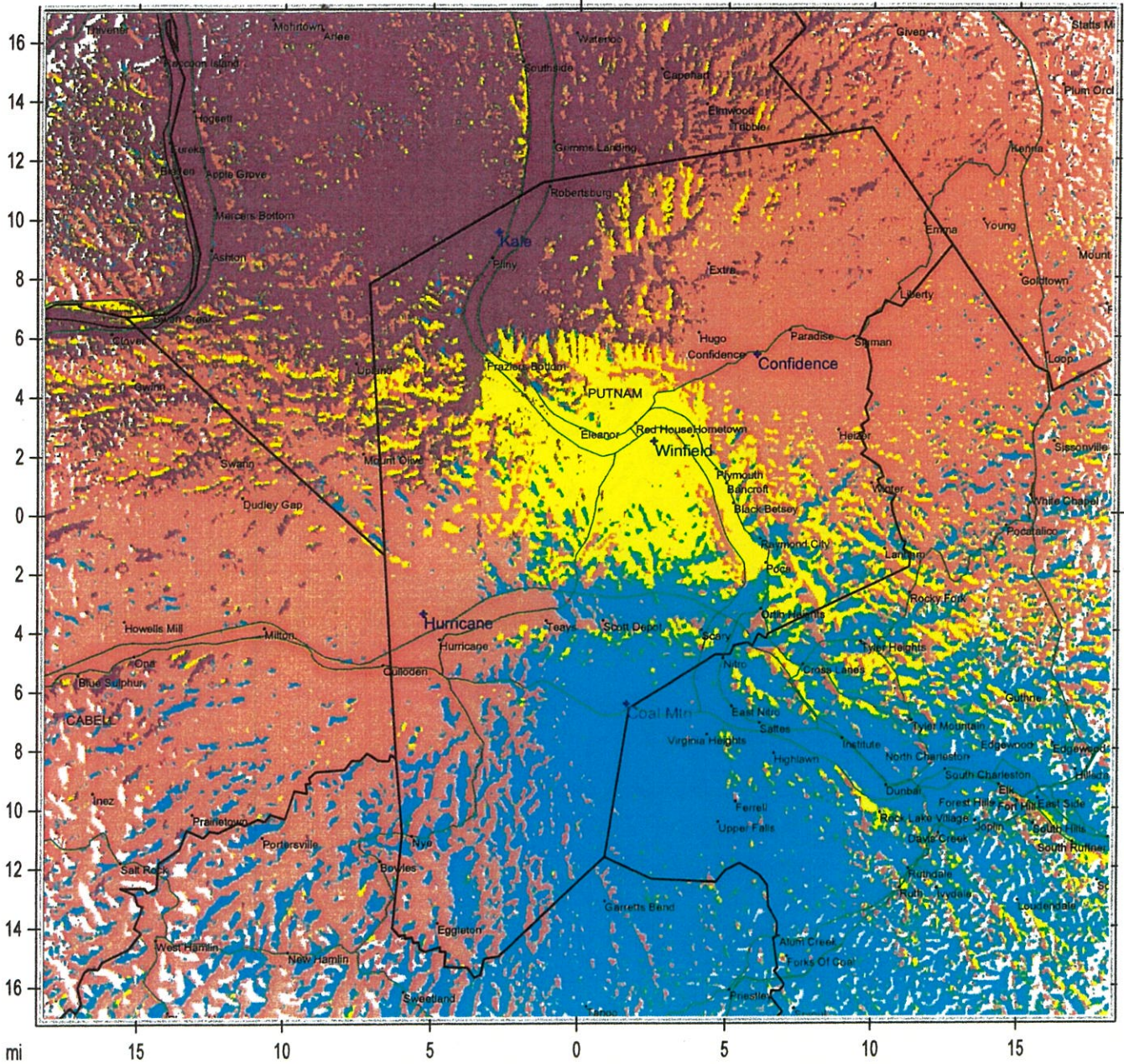

Putnam Proposed VHF Mobile Talk Back - Most Likely Server

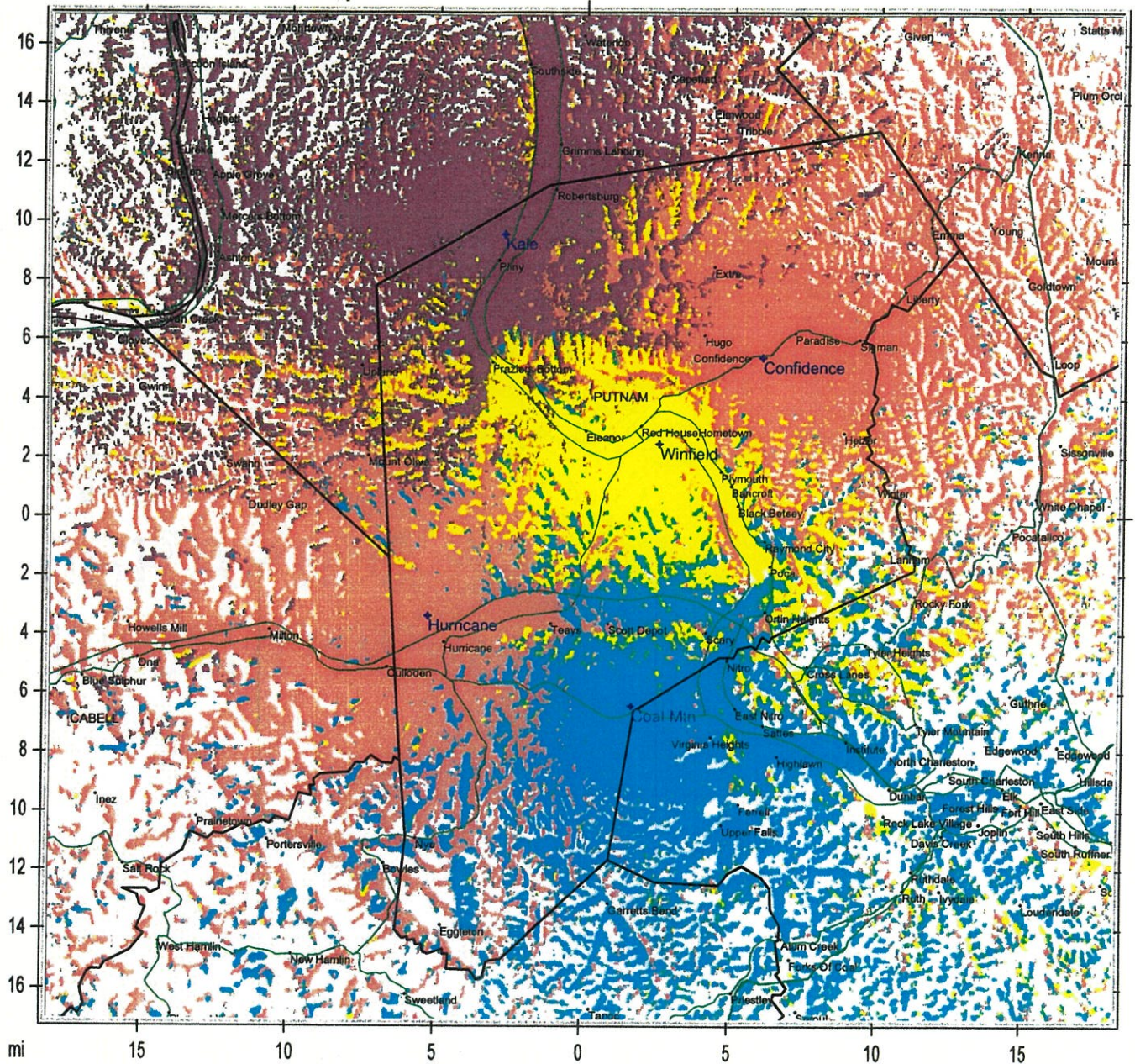
