THE COUNTY COMMISSION OF MASON COUNTY met in the Commission room of the courthouse on Thursday, April 17, 2025, at 4:00 p.m. in regular session. Present were Rick Handley, President; Sam Nibert, Commissioner; Chris Johnson, Commissioner; Diana Cromley, County Clerk; and Jason Bechtle, Administrator.

Rick Handley called the meeting to order. Diana Cromley gave the opening prayer, and Chris Johnson led the Pledge of Allegiance.

The Commission also recognized the passing of Miles Epling, Jr. on April 13, 2025 and observed a moment of silence on his family's behalf. Miles served the county as a Circuit Clerk, Magistrate and Commissioner. He also served as American Legion Post Commander, State Adjutant and National Commander.

Steven Holmes with the West Virginia Department of Highways notified the Commission that he would reschedule a visit to Mason County and was hopeful for future funding for Mason County roads.

Upon motion by Nibert and unanimous agreement, the Commission approved Estate Appointments, Affidavits for Small Estates, Orders Appointing Fiduciary Commissioners, Waivers of Final Settlement, Reports of Receipts and Disbursements, Commissioner's Reports of Claims and Final Settlement, and Applications for Corrections of Erroneous Assessments. Copies of which are attached hereto.

Upon motion by Johnson and unanimous agreement, the Commission minutes from the previous meeting were approved with no omissions or corrections thereto.

The Commission executed the Bills and Purchase Orders as required.

Cromley discussed a citizen's request and her efforts in pursuing the naming of the unincorporated rural area along Ripley Road from Thomas Ridge Road to Gill Ridge Road "Rollins town".

The Commission signed an Order regarding the Sidney Bauer Estate, a copy of which is of record in the Mason County Clerk's Office.

Upon motion by Johnson and unanimous agreement, the Commission approved a Proclamation declaring April 13 through April 19, 2025 National Telecommunicators Week in Mason County, a copy of which Proclamation is attached. In recognition of the same, the Commission posed for photos with representatives of the 911 Center: Jeremy Bryant, Matthew Shell, Jessica Kearns, Victoria Haynes and Cheryl Whitt.

Upon motion by Nibert and unanimous agreement, the Commission approved the use of the Mason County Library lawn for a National Day of Prayer event on May 1, 2025.

Upon motion by Johnson and unanimous agreement, the Commission approved the following hires: Brandon Walters and Madison Carpenter to full-time Transport Paramedic positions with the EMS effective May 1, 2025.

Upon motion by Nibert and unanimous agreement, the Commission approved the following hire: Ben See to a full-time Telecommunicator position with the 911 Centr effective June 1, 2025.

The Commission was informed that the EMS will do a soft launch on May 1, 2025 of its 24-hour transport service with Rivers Health.

Upon motion by Nibert and unanimous agreement, the Commission approved supporting Congressional spending for the Mason County Farm Museum.

Upon motion by Nibert and unanimous agreement, the Commission approved a Memorandum of Understanding with the Board of Education to provide Opioid Settlement funding in the amount of \$142,542.00 for the employment of two social workers, a copy of which is attached.

The Commission discussed the potential need for a designated EMS truck to provide transport services for the Leon area. Bechtle and EMS Director Scott Ballard will research the matter for further discussion.

The Commission discussed the exterior renovation project, construction needs and projected costs. The steel lintel is separating from the window which will require the removal of two rows of bricks, cutting the lintel back and then replacing the brick. The front steps also need lifted up and repaired. The projected cost for the steps and lintel repair is \$18,500. The Commission tabled a decision on the matter until the next meeting.

Upon motion by Nibert and unanimous agreement, the Commission canceled the Commission meeting on June 26, moved the June 12 meeting to June 5, moved the July 17 meeting to July 3, and canceled the July 31 meeting.

The Commission reviewed an estimate from Medcognition, Inc. for an EMS training system and tabled approval of the expenditure until the next meeting. A copy of said estimate is attached.

WHEREAS, each April, agencies across the country take time to honor the unsung heroes of emergency response during National Public Safety Telecommunicators Week. This year, from April 13th to 19th, Mason County joins communities nationwide in recognizing the dedication, skill, and commitment of our 911 Communications Specialists staff. These individuals are often referred to as the Nation's true "First, First Responders," and for good reason. They are the calm in the chaos, the guiding voice in our darkest moments, and the critical link between crisis and response;

WHEREAS, National Telecommunicators Week was first established in 1981 by Patricia Anderson of the Contra Costa County Sheriff's Office in California. It was later nationally recognized by Congress in 1991. Since then, the week has grown into a nationwide celebration of the professionals who answer emergency calls, provide lifesaving instructions, and coordinate the swift response of police, fire, and emergency medical personnel. In a world filled with uncertainty, their steady voices bring order and hope.

WHEREAS, in Mason County, our Communications Center operates 24/7. The staff is composed of highly trained telecommunicators who manage thousands of calls annually, many of which are true life-and-death situations. Their job requires quick decision-making, thorough knowledge of protocols, and the ability to remain composed during emergencies. Every call they take represents a person in need, a life at stake, or a community moment requiring clear, decisive communication.

WHEREAS, the employee reflects the care and dedication shown by the telecommunicators themselves. Every shift, our staff embodies empathy and professionalism. When someone dials 911, the person on the other end of the line may be the first reassuring voice they hear amid tragedy or confusion. Whether it's helping a parent administer CPR to their child, coordinating emergency services to a multi-vehicle crash, or calming a caller experiencing a mental health crisis, our telecommunicators do more than answer the phone. They provide clarity, safety, and sometimes, a lifeline.
