WHEREAS, in the Ordinance the County Commission also approved the issuance of Lease Revenue Bonds (the "Bonds") by the Issuer for the purpose of financing the cost of acquiring the former Mason County Armory and paying costs in association therewith:

WHEREAS, following a solicitation of proposals from various banks, the County Commission now desires to approve a subsequent commitment letter from Ohio Valley Bank for the purchase of the Bonds, a copy of which is attached hereto as EXHIBIT A – COMMITMENT LETTER (the "Commitment Letter"); and

WHEREAS, the County Commission desires to take all steps necessary to authorize the acquisition of the Property by the Issuer, the issuance of the Bonds by the Issuer pursuant to the terms of the Commitment Letter to finance the costs of such acquisition and the payment of the costs of issuance thereof and related costs, the requisitioning by the Issuer of the Bond proceeds and application thereof to the payment of the costs of the acquisition of the Property and the costs of issuance of the Bonds and its leasing of the Facilities from the Issuer pursuant to the terms of the Lease;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNTY COMMISSION OF MASON COUNTY, AS FOLLOWS:

<u>Section 1</u>. The issuance and sale of the Bonds by the Issuer pursuant to the terms of the Commitment Letter is hereby approved and authorized.

Section 2. The County Commission shall, subject to the provisions thereof, make lease payments in such amounts as required to pay principal of and interest on the Bonds pursuant to the terms of the Commitment Letter.

<u>Section 3</u>. The County Commission hereby ratifies all actions, whether previously taken or required to be taken by the County Commission, its officers, employees and agents, in the future, necessary on the part of the County Commission to authorize and approve the acquisition of the former Mason County Armory by the Issuer, the issuance of the Bonds by the Issuer and the leasing of the former Mason County Armory from the Issuer by the County Commission.

<u>Section 4</u>. Except as specifically provided herein, all provisions of the Ordinance remain in full force and effect.

Section 5. This Supplemental Resolution shall take effect immediately upon adoption.
